Please note the following:

- The Schedule-at-a-Glance now lists courses by divisions rather than by format, and it includes information regarding the format and meeting dates for each course in an adjacent column.
- The Schedule-at-a-Glance now includes rotations for courses that are taught less often than once a year. (These rotations were previously found in the Scheduling Template. Because these are now part of the Schedule-at-a-Glance, there is no further need for the Scheduling Template, and it is being discontinued as a separate document.
- Courses offered every year in the same term are listed in the next three sections (one section for each semester or term) without highlighting. **Courses offered in 2019-20 on less-than-annual rotations are also in those three sections, with yellow highlighting to alert you to the fact that they are on longer-term rotations.** Students who wish to know what courses will be offered in subsequent years in those slots may consult the final three sections of this document (one section for each division). We cannot promise that we will be able to follow the rotations exactly, but we present this information to you as representing our best intentions.
- As always, the information about each course will be more specific in the Course Schedule (put out by the Registration Office shortly before registration opens in a given semester or term) than in the Schedule-at-a-Glance. Thus, please use the Schedule-at-a-Glance for long-term planning and for planning the upcoming academic year, and the Course Schedule for planning the next semester or term.
- Please note that the dates for modules and residencies are for the 2019-20 academic year. Obviously, for subsequent years, the dates will change, but we intend to offer the courses in the same formats and time slots in those future years.
- For all courses except counseling, you are allowed to be present in the class sessions, tutorials, and other meetings by Zoom. In this sense, all of the non-counseling courses are “Digital Live.” In some cases, the course meetings are Zoom only, and in others you may be present in the classroom in person or by Zoom.
